## **Drivewyze**

#### 1 What Are Safety Notifications?

Drivewyze Safety Notifications are virtual road signs that appear on your in-cab device as you approach an unsafe driving area. You may see notifications when approaching rollover zones, low bridges, work zones, restricted roads or any other unsafe road segment.

#### 2 How Does it Work?

Notifications are triggered at a safe distance ahead of a risk zone, based on the road speed.

The in-cab device will beep

A virtual road sign will appear on your in-cab device.

To dismiss the alert, tap the screen.

## 3 Rollover Zones

## Rollover Zones may appear at sharp exits or curvy roads.

You will receive an alert approximately 1000 feet ahead of the zone.

Slow down, and follow your fleet's speeding policy in the curve.

#### 4 Low Bridges

These warnings may appear as you approach railroads, overpasses, tunnels or bridges with low clearance (13'6,, or lower).

Use discretion and reroute, if necessary, to avoid bridges that are lower than the height of your trailer or load.





Drivewyze Risk Zones are selected based on CMV traffic density and collision history. Not all risky driving areas will trigger notifications. Drivewyze Safety Notifications are not a substitute for truck-safe navigation. Drivers are still responsible for following posted safety signs and using their judgement to drive safely.

## MAINTENCE AND WEATHER REMINDERS:

EVEN THOUGH TEMPERATURES ARE STILL UP IN A LOT OF THE COUNTRY, WE NEED TO WATCH IDLING THE TRUCKS TOO MUCH. WITH FUEL COSTS CONTINUING TO INCREASE AND POSSIBLE DOWN TIME DUE TO SHOP REPAIRS, TRY AND GET OUT OF THE TRUCK WHEN NOT ON 10 HR BREAK IF AT ALL POSSIBLE AND GIVE THE TRUCK A BREAK FROM IDLING.

Anytime you replace the head light bulbs on truck, use either paper towel or plastic bag so the oil from you hands due not leave residue on the bulbs and shorten the life of the bulbs.


